A Note From Our Rector

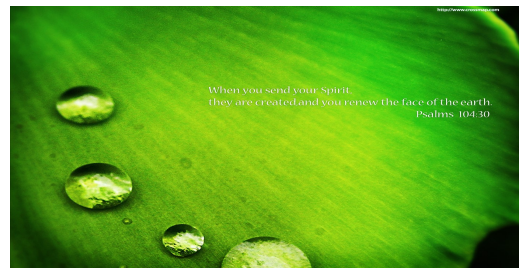
It's been the rainiest July I can remember. Not that I don't appreciate the rain... I do. I love a thunderstorm, as long as I'm not out in it. I love watching the clouds gather in the distance; hearing the thunder boom and roll as it slowly comes nearer. I love sitting on our back porch feeling the wind move from stillness to rustling the tops of the trees, and back to still calm again. Then as the rain begins, there is a freshness to the drenching. A baptism of the earth, the rain renews the ground and the plants drink up. The water is poured over us in the Name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy BOOM. As the psalmist says of God, "You send forth your Spirit and they (we) are created; and so You renew the face of the earth." (Psalm 104:30)

God is a renewing God. Our Scriptures tell of God's love for us and we... indeed all of life, and the whole universe... everything that is, has been created out of love. So it is the nature of who God is, to lovingly renew all creation... even us. We are continually renewed. It is God's good love for you that is the greatest. Another word for it from the Bible is "Grace." The meaning of "grace" in the Bible is God's extending of love to us. It

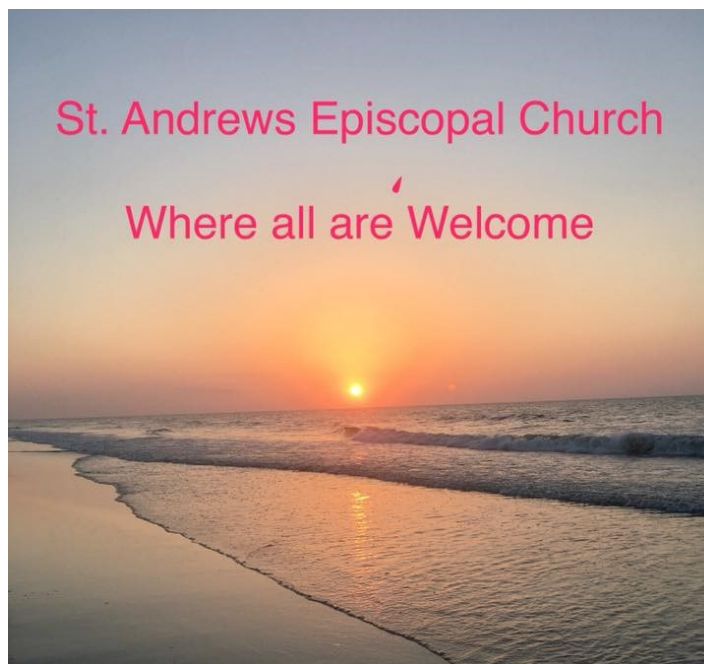
